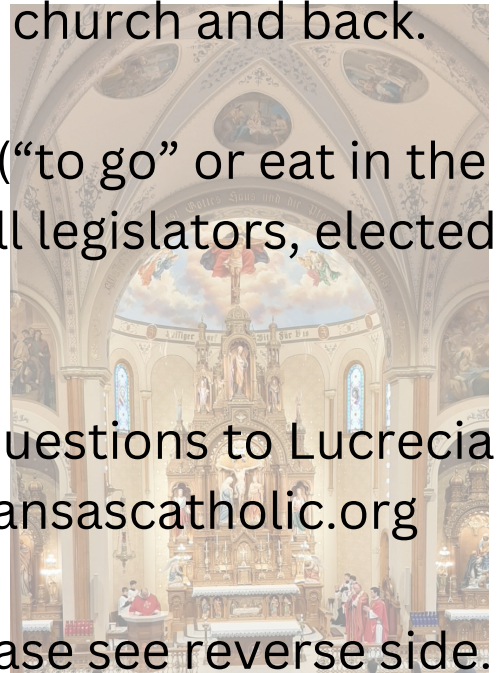
Details:
